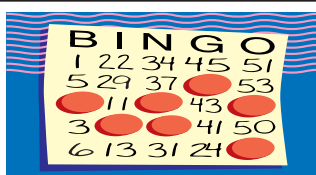


## Spagetti Luncheon Earned \$981.00 for Playground
