## It's Pecan Time Again in Tennessee!

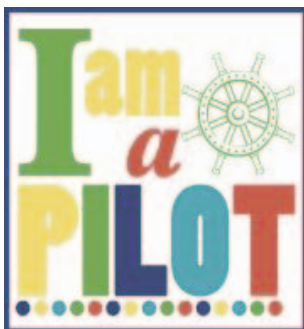

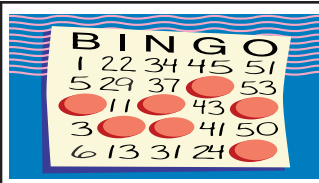


## I am a Pilot

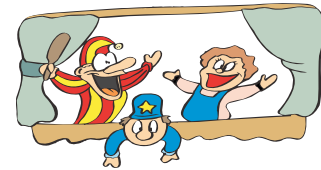

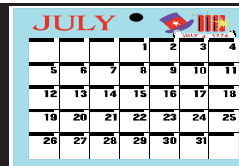


## Festival Of Friends
